The COVID 19 vaccination is already started by State and Central governments and mass level vaccination drive is to be rolled out soon. As per the advice from government bodies and various organisations, differently abled people will be given priority in this process as they are more vulnerable to pandemic. We provide one to one support to register for vaccination as well as field support in case of any requirement.



Most of the differently abled people and especially children with multiple disabilities will require regular medical support and monitoring. In pandemic time this has to be guaranteed without any shortage or delay. As part of this project emergency medicine and ambulance service are channelized in coordination with local voluntary groups.





COVID pandemic and its mandatory precautionary measures like lock down have imposed restrictions in our daily lives. This is adversely affecting persons with disabilities and children with special needs, especially in their therapy domains. Sustained and regular therapies are inevitable for improvement in the disability condition. Such therapies cannot be kept defunct for a long period. Specific therapies need to be continued on a regular basis. With this goal, we have arranged one to one online therapy sessions via virtual platforms. A team of qualified rehabilitation professionals in Occupational Therapy (OT), Physiotherapy (PT), Special Education (SE), Speech and Hearing, Clinical Psychology (CP) and Behaviour Therapy (BT) are there to serve you online.



Mental health issues ranging from simple stress and worries to exacerbation of existing mental illness are astonishingly increasing in this unprecedented pandemic period. Retaining our mental health is as important as maintaining our physical well being. We provide 24×7 counselling, psychotherapy, befriending, psychiatry referral (if needed) and follow up services, through the KIRAN mental health rehabilitation helpline number 18005990019 of the Ministry of Social Justice, Government of India. A qualified Clinical Psychologist will be available to address all your mental health concerns online - 24 x7.
